U7 Programming - Select 1 of 4 Options Playing on Modified Ice

- 1. House League: participants will be on the ice 2 times per week. House League game and a House League skills session.
- 2. House League with Additional Development Training: participants will be on the ice up to 3 times per week. House League game and skills session as well as one additional practice on skill development. There will be an additional cost for this skill development hour. Day and time of this development hour will be provided in the Fall.
- 3. U7 CPP Select Tier 1 Team: participants on this team will participate in House League. This team will be on the ice up to 4 times per week. Preparation phase/ Evaluation phase / Development phase will be held in the Fall. This team will practice as a team on a weekly basis. Additional costs are associated to participating on this team. This team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program.
- 4. U7 CPP Select Tier 2 Team: participants on this team will participate in House League. This team will be on the ice up to 4 times per week. Preparation phase/ Evaluation phase / Development phase will be held in the Fall. This team will practice as a team on a weekly basis. Additional costs are associated to participating on this team. This team will be comprised of players that did not qualify for the U7 Select Tier 1 team. This team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program.



U8 Programming - Select 1 of 4 Options Playing on Modified Ice

- House League: participants will be on the ice 2 times per week. House League game and a House League skills session.
- 2. House League with Additional Development
 Training: participants will be on the ice up to 3 times per
 week. House League game and skills session as well as one
 additional practice on skill development. There will be an additional
 cost for this skill development hour. Day and time of this
 development hour will be provided in the Fall.
- 3. U8 CPP Select Team: participants on this team will participate in House League. This team will be on the ice up to 4 times per week. Preparation phase/ Evaluation phase / Development phase will be held in the Fall. This team will practice as a team on a weekly basis. Additional costs are associated to participating on this team. This team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program.
- 4. U8 MD Team: this team will not participate in House League and be considered a Development Team. This team will be on the ice up to 4 or 5 times per week. Preparation phase/ Evaluation phase / Development phase will be conducted in the Fall to select this team. Costs to play on this team will be based on the team's budget.



U9 Programming - Select 1 of 4 Options Playing on Modified Ice (half season)

- 1. House League: participants will be on the ice 2 times per week. House League game and a House League skills session.
- 2. House League with Additional Development
 Training: participants will be on the ice up to 3 times per
 week. House League game and skills session as well as one
 additional practice on skill development. There will be an additional
 cost for this skill development hour. Day and time of this
 development hour will be provided in the Fall.
- 3. U9 CPP Select Team: participants on this team will participate in House League. Preparation phase/ Evaluations/ Tiering will be held in the Fall. This team will practice as a team on a weekly basis. Additional costs are associated to participating on this team. This team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program.
- 4. U9 MD Team: this team will not participate in House League and be considered a Development Team. This team will be on the ice up to 4 or 5 times per week. Preparation phase/ Evaluation phase / Development phase will be conducted in the Fall to select this team. Costs to play on this team will be based on the team's budget. This is a Development Team and will follow Hockey Canada programming.

Select games and practices are during the week beginning at 5:00 pm. Occasionally on the weekend at times not conflicting with House League ice times.

When does the season end?

Season play ends at the end of January and playoffs end at the end of March

Up to 4 tournaments per season

Season ends at the end of March

Up to 3 tournaments per season

For Pathway Age Groups (U9 and below), tournaments are referred to as "Jamborees"

May I be rostered to a Clippers AA/A team as an Affiliate Player (AP)?

Clippers Rep (AA/A) Clippers Select

What is the estimated cost per season?

Average of \$4500

Each team sets its own budget which varies by category (AA/A/MD) and depends on the amount of ice purchased, the number of tournaments attended and the team merchandise

purchased, among

other things.

Average from \$750 to \$1,200

House league fees plus Select team fees, which range from \$750 to approx. \$1,200 depending on the team budget. Team parents have input into the budget.

Lake Ontario Region (LOR) Rules

 Only affects residents of Toronto, Mississauga, Vaughan, Markham, Richmond Hill, Ajax/Pickering, Oakville, Brampton and allows players to play with teams outside of their municipality of residence. Stouffville Minor Hockey is not part of these rules, therefore cannot accept players from other associations with the same level and cannot release players who reside in Stouffville to go play for another association if they are offering the same levels.
