



York Simcoe Minor Hockey League Guide for Visiting Teams

The Province has implemented a vaccine requirement for individuals entering recreation facilities, coming into effect **September 22nd, 2021**.

All Participants, parents/guardians/spectators will be required to show proof of vaccination (second dose received at least 14 days prior to visit) or a letter stating a medical exemption each time they enter a recreation facility, with the following exemptions:

- * children under the age of 12
- * Youth under the age of 18 who are actively participating in an organized sport

Effective Nov, 1st YORK REGION WILL REQUIRE - ALL Participants/Coaches/Spectators/Volunteers to be fully vaccinated to enter any facility. Until Nov 1st, players and coaches are exempt only.

Additionally, the OMHA has mandated that all eligible participants involved in minor hockey are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 for the upcoming season. **All eligible participants are required to be fully vaccinated by October 31, 2021.**
